Painted Seashells

Grades 3-8


Materials:

Clean seashells	Brushes
Tempera paint	Newspapers
Liquid soap	Containers for the paint

FAITH CONNECTION

Point out that it is common for priests and deacons to use a seashell to pour the waters of baptism over the heads of those being baptized.





Directions:

- 1. Mix a few drops of liquid soap into the tempera paint. The soap will help the paint stick to the shell.
- 2. Have the students paint their names and dates of Baptism on the outside of the shells.
- **3.** Have the students paint an appropriate scene on the inside of the shells.
